

# Vivary Way Works Profile



**CLIENT:** Lancashire County Council

**LOCATION** Vivary Way, Colne

**VALUE:** £175,000

**DURATION:** 12 weeks

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS:

The work involved the construction of a new spur road off an existing roundabout at the end of the M65 motorway.

The new spur road will eventually provide access to a new private retail park which is to be built at a later date.

The roundabout was reduced to single lane using a TM sub-contractor between 9am and 3pm each day to allow construction of the new access road.

Drainage and ducting works were also involved and directional drilling techniques were used to do 3 N° road crossings. This technique was chosen so as to minimise the amount of disruption to traffic movements and to avoid any future potential settlement problems that open cut trenching can cause.

All works excluding the no dig crossings were completed in-house. This included the excavation, drainage, ducting, street lighting and signage and surfacing works.

The works were delivered on programme.
